



## 2018 USA Volleyball National Scorer Candidate Application Information, Instructions, & Checklist

1. Applicants must be in good standing with their region and the USAV Indoor Officials Commission, if applicable, throughout the candidate process.
2. Applicants must complete the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum online by May 31, 2018. This curriculum includes the USAV National scorer exam. Instructions for completing all requirements are available in a separate document at: [http://www.volleyballreftraining.com/resources\\_applications.php](http://www.volleyballreftraining.com/resources_applications.php).
3. Candidate must register in Webpoint for National Scorer Candidate Clinic and pay the \$150 fee.
  - a. Current National Referees may seek a refund of \$50 by contacting Kathy Ferraraccio via email at [Kathy@ferraraccio.com](mailto:Kathy@ferraraccio.com)
  - b. Please use this subject line: National Scorer Candidate Refund – Last Name, First Name. Ex: National Scorer Candidate Refund – Doe, Jane
    - Failure to do this could delay your refund as a result in application material being lost in inboxes.
    - The refund will be processed in 48 hours if all steps are followed.
4. The application must be submitted via email. It can be downloaded from the USAV Academy from the course 2017-2018 National Scorer Candidate Application Materials under Course Materials.
5. Complete the application process no later than **April 1, 2018**. The National Scorer Candidate Application form must be filled out completely and then submitted by the applicant via email per instructions.
  - a. No paper applications will be accepted.
  - b. Electronic signatures will be allowed.
  - c. The Application will close at 11:59 MT.
  - d. Application must include commissioner and referee/scorer chair in cc or they will be rejected.
  - e. Please use the subject line: National Scorer Application – Last Name, First Name. Ex: National Scorer Application – Doe, Jane.
    - Failure to do this will not necessarily disqualify, but could result in application material being lost in inboxes.
6. Any applicant not accepted as a candidate will be refunded the full application fee.
7. Failure to meet any of the above listed deadlines will result in disqualification from the National Scorer candidacy program this season.
8. All properly submitted applications will be reviewed, and all applicants will be notified of acceptance or non-acceptance as a National scorer candidate by **May 1, 2018**.
9. If you are a current Junior National or National referee and intend on attending the Boys' Junior National Championships as a referee when not a scorer candidate, please register to officiate on VolleyballRefTraining.com at <http://www.volleyballreftraining.net/events.php>. Please note that you will not referee any matches during the scorer rating process. If you are eligible for OCRP you **MUST** pay for your part of the room for the date of your rating.
10. The 2018 Boys' JNC will be held in Phoenix, Arizona, at the Phoenix Convention Center from July 2-9. All candidates are required to check in at the playing venue by 7:00 PM the day before their rating. You must be available with no schedule conflicts during your one-day rating session which will be on **July 2, 3, or 4**. You may depart the event any time after 10:00 AM the day after your rating session, or you may stay to referee after the rating session has ended.
11. If you are part of the OCRP and fail to pay for your hotel room during your candidacy by September 15, you will not be eligible for OCRP in the future. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

# National Scorer Candidate Curriculum

National scorer candidates are required to complete the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum. This must be completed by the application deadline, **May 31, 2018**, along with all other paperwork associated with candidacy.

For candidates who have already taken the modules or exams for their national level-certification requirements, it is not necessary to re-take these modules, as long as it was taken on VolleyballRefTraining.com for credit. We are able to access your records on USA Volleyball Academy and know when you completed all requirements.

## Instructions for Completing the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum

1. Log onto Webpoint; <https://webpoint.usavolleyball.org>
2. Click on Event Registration; this will bring a drop down box
3. From the drop down box click on USAV Ref/Score clinics
4. Locate the 2017-18 National Scorer Application Materials and click REGISTER
5. To access the Academy, log onto Webpoint and click, Go to USAV Academy. You will be logged into the Academy.

### Tips for taking courses/exams

- Make sure your flash player is up to date and running.
- Make sure pop-ups are not blocked on your computer.

### When having issues with a course/quiz/exam

- Clear your browser history and restart your computer before resuming your exam/course.
- Attempt to access the material via a different browser.
- Attempt to access the course material via another computer.

6. Once in the USA Volleyball Academy, view curricula you have registered for and take exams and modules. The courses for National Scorer Candidates are:
  - National Scorer Candidate Procedures
  - Getting Rated
  - Professionalism II
  - Scoring Sanctions
  - Scoring Special Situations
  - National Scorer Clinic
  - National Scorer Exam (Passing: 90%)
7. When you have completed curricula in USAV Academy, that information will be captured in Webpoint.
8. **All coursework must be completed by May 31, 2017**

## National Scorer Candidate Checklist

To apply and be considered as a candidate for USAV National scorer certification, an applicant must complete/submit the following:

- Online application completed by **April 1, 2018**
- National Scorer Candidate Curriculum completed online no later than **May 31, 2018**

In addition, the following requirements must be met:

- Current USAV background screen must be on file at time of application
- USAV National Official Commission dues must have been paid by November 15, 2017  
(if a USAV National-level referee)
